The IDPH Licensed Home Care Program provides assistance regardless of age. The program is offered to anyone in need of personal care and/or various help.

The IDPH Licensed Home Care Services include basic housekeeping, personal care assistance, outside home assistance (shopping, assisting clients to doctor appointments, etc.) as well as medication reminders.
